**FALL 2024 PASTORAL CARE TRAINING SESSION**

**ST. JOSEPH’S CAMP—LABOUR DAY WEEKEND**

Saint Joseph’s Camp is an opportunity for Catholic fathers and sons and single men to grow in faith together by sharing a fun, spirit-filled weekend. We’ll share sports, woodworking and other activities, as well as spiritual gifts like the Rosary and Mass.

The camp will take place during the Labour Day long weekend at Camp Morice on Stuart Lake, beginning at 3:00pm on Friday August 30th and concluding with a hike up Mount Pope on Monday September 2nd.

Bunkhouse accommodation is provided or you may bring your own trailer or tent. Participants bring their own food but meals may be prepared in common (more details on meals will be provided upon registration).

Registration is open until Friday, August 23rd at \$40 per person for the first two people in one family, and \$10 per person for each member of the family after that. Participants aged 7 and up are welcome; all minors must be accompanied by a chaperone.
