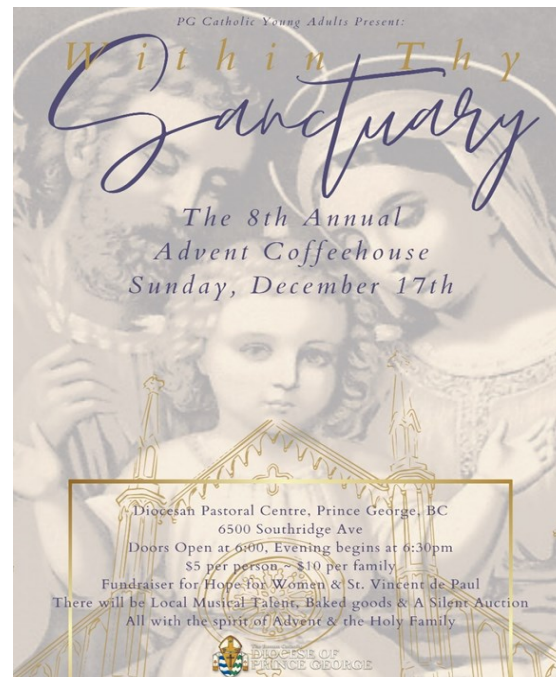


Mitten Tree
