Letter from Fr. Terry to the parishioners of Christ Our Saviour

August 16, 2026

Dear parishioners, Christ Our Saviour,

I have been with you, serving as your pastor for about three weeks.

You have welcomed me very warmly and I appreciate that very much. Every parish is “warm” but not every parish knows how to welcome a priest as you have. I have already pointed out the initial welcome, a clean rectory, stocked refrigerator, clean sheets and bedding. This all happened prior to my coming here. Since my arrival there has been a bee hive of activity on the Church grounds and inside the Church itself. Martin and his son Adam replaced many of the rotten boards on the rectory fence and gave the entire fence a new coat of paint. Norm and his boys have beautified the Church grounds and numerous parishioners are caring for the flowers. Many people are involved in beautifying the parish that you, so it seems to me, love very much.

Every parish has their gifts and weaknesses but you have many gifts and for this I am very grateful. In short, you make easy for me to be your pastor.

My agenda as your Pastor is as follows: I would like to visit parishioners but I would like to begin with those who have distanced themselves from the parish. We all know someone who fits that category, those rightly or wrongly who feel pushed out and consequently no longer attend Mass. If you can assist me in this endeavour, please give me the name, telephone number, email etc., and place in a sealed envelope. I would also want to receive from you any name of an elderly parishioner who used to come on Sunday but because of age or sickness, no longer attends Mass. I visit three people, names that were given to me. If you can add to those three, write the names down, include telephone and email if you can and put in a sealed envelope. You can give this to me, put it in the collection basket on Sunday, or slied under the office door. In short, I want to do what Jesus told his disciples to do, “**bring back the lost sheep**”.
